

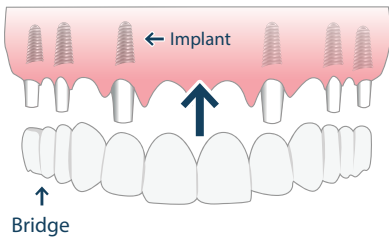

CHEAT SHEET FOR REPLACING ALL OF YOUR TEETH

YOU CAN DO NOTHING

If you do nothing, you will continue to hate all the things you already dislike about your teeth or your dentures. Regular dentures don't stay in place, you can't eat the foods you enjoy, and they can have a highly negative impact on your self confidence. What is it worth to you to be able to enjoy the foods you love again? To feel confident in your smile? If you are interested, read on!



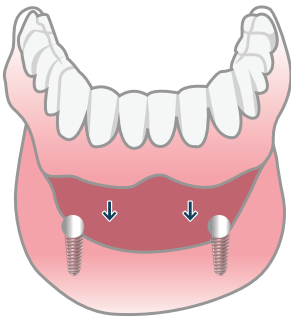
OPTION 1: FULL MOUTH IMPLANTS AND RECONSTRUCTION

Replace all your teeth with 8-10 implants per arch and a full set of porcelain crowns and bridges. This is the most expensive option because it requires major bone grafting, multiple surgeries, and lots of implants. It can cost up to \$50,000 per arch, and can take 12-24 months.



OPTION 2: FIXED IMPLANT BRIDGE

This is the most popular option today. It is virtually the same as Option 1, but it can be done with less surgery, using half the implants, and at significantly less cost — from \$22,000-\$32,000 per arch. And the best part...you can leave with new teeth in just ONE day!



OPTION 3: IMPLANT SUPPORTED SNAP-ON DENTURE

This is a REMOVABLE option (Option 1 and 2 are FIXED in your mouth and never come out). You save some cost, but because it's removable it's not quite as stable or natural feeling. This is a popular option for patients who want something a lot better than regular dentures, but don't mind that their teeth are removable and come in and out. This can cost \$6,000-\$12,000.



OPTION 4: REGULAR COMPLETE DENTURE

This is the cheapest option, but also the most limiting. They cost \$500-\$5,000. Regular dentures move, slide, and rub on your gums causing soreness as well as smiling and eating problems. While regular dentures do replace all the missing teeth in the smile, food choices are typically limited to softer items (i.e. soup, fish or oatmeal) and bone loss will continue to occur requiring new dentures periodically.
